



Tanzanian Camping Safari – set departures 2000

As a result of the demand created by the recent surge in popularity in Tanzanian safaris, The East African Safari And Touring Company are proud to announce a series of set departures for 2000, intended to introduce the interested visitor to the major attractions of the Tanzanian Northern Safari Circuit. The safaris will be six day/five night departures visiting Tarangire OR Lake Manyara (depending on the season), Serengeti and Ngorongoro and will be leaving Arusha on the following dates:

December 5th and 12th 1999

December 10th and 24th

- These safaris leave on Sunday mornings and are designed to fall in with KLM (from Amsterdam), Air Tanzania (from Jo'Burg) and Ethiopian Air (from Addis/Europe) flights of the previous day as well as our Rongai ascents of Kilimanjaro.
- The maximum group size will be 12 and they will be transported in 4WD land-rovers with English-speaking driver-guides. Each client will be guaranteed a window seat in the L/R which have viewing hatches for use in game drives
- All camping equipment is ex-SA with large, walk-in dome tents, camp cot-style beds with mattresses and pillows, all bedding and wash stands outside each tent. Each tent will have a tilley lamp. There will also be a mess tent on every departure, a long covered trestle table and fisherman's stools with green canvas backs for each client. There will also be eating utensils for every client.
- Food is of a good and plentiful standard with specialist dietary requirements catered for with due notice.
- We use National Park campsites in Serengeti and Ngorogoro which have African long-drop toilets and cold showers when water levels permit. When using Tarangire National Park (from June 1st until January 1st) we will be bush camping in Tarangire Conservation Area. Our camp sites have been chosen for their shade and positions of outstanding natural beauty.



- Long-drop toilets will be dug and a tripod toilet seat provided and a shower tent will be erected. The equivalent sum to the National Park Fees will be paid to the Conservation Fund that benefits the local villages.
- In Lake Manyara National Park (January-June 1st), we will be using the National Park bandas situated at the main

The itinerary unfurls as follows:-

Day One

Meet in Arusha. Transfer to Tarangire or Manyara, depending on season. Afternoon Game drive in National Park and transfer to our camp.

Day Two

An early morning drive (in Manyara) or early morning foot safari (in Tarangire) before a drive across the Rift Valley to the Serengeti, game viewing en-route. O/N Seronera Camp

Day Three

Full Day game-viewing in the Serengeti with early morning and afternoon game-drives. Lunch and Siesta at camp. O/N Seronera Camp
There is an optional balloon safari available for 375USD per person on this morning. Contact us for more details.

Day Four

A morning game drive in the Serengeti before we leave behind the great plains. We lunch at Olduvai gorge, The Cradle Of Mankind, and site of the discovery of Man's earliest ancestors before climbing into the Ngorogoro Highlands to camp on the Crater Rim

Day five

A full day exploring Ngorogoro Crater, a wildlife amphitheatre justifiably dubbed the eighth wonder of the world and Garden of Eden. It is the best place to put the last ticks in your wildlife checklist before the safari finishes. We camp at Simba camp

Day 6

After a large breakfast, we make our way back to Arusha arriving in time for flights to Zanzibar and a beach idyll or transfers to Kilimanjaro and the climb of a lifetime.

The price for this safari will be 840USD per person inclusive of all park fees, camp fees (camping inside National Parks, wherever possible)
